

Frequently Asked Questions: Call for Abstracts

1. What is the deadline for submitting abstracts?

Entry period submissions: September 1st – November 1st, 2025.

2. When do I get notified if my abstract is accepted?

Notification of acceptance: December 1st, 2025.

3. What are the topics?

Topics: mobility, energy transition, circularity, digitalization, urban food systems, climate adaptation, Living Lab methodology. You can also indicate if your research is contributing to resilient, regenerative and just cities.

4. What type of presentations can I choose?

- a. *Full Paper presentation*: suitable for papers that (almost) finished. You have 20 minutes to present your research, followed by questions from discussants. These are traditional oral paper presentations. You may be placed with other paper presentors in the same session.
- b. *Pitch & Polish presentation*: suitable for research ideas or or for papers that are still in development. You have 6 minutes to present, followed by other presentations. After the presentations, a group discussion or questions may follow. These presentations are inspired by the "Pecha Kucha" format.
- c. *Special sessions*: sessions for consortia and projects that can consist of paper presentations, panel discussions or another form that fits the purpose of the consortium. See more information in art.5.

5. What are the rules for special sessions?

AMS Institute will invite consortia and projects to organize a special session. However, if you (as part of a consortium or project) are also interested in organizing a special session, you may submit a proposal directly to us. A session's objectives, expected collaborators, the intended audience, and the type of session need to be specified.

To submit as a group, a minimum of 6 conference tickets is required.

6. What are the ticket prices?

8. What are the rules for the 'Best paper for young scientists'?
